No need to register! Just bring yourself, a friend and an open mind.

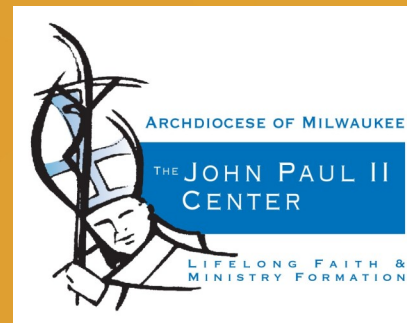
### What if I Don't Drink Alcohol?

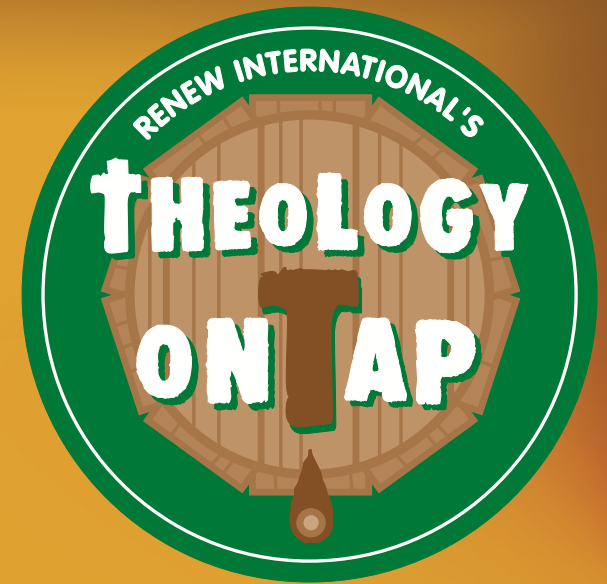
There is no pressure to drink at any of the sites.
